

2. Objects of the Association are:

- (a) to provide a forum for the interchange of information and opinion by Churchill Fellows;
- (b) to advise and assist, so far as is proper, applicants for Fellowships in the preparation of their applications;
- (c) to assist Fellows from any part of the world in any proper and reasonable way;
- (d) to entertain Fellows from any part of the world;
- (e) to represent the interests of Churchill Fellows; and
- (f) to co-operate and assist with the work and objectives of the National Office of The Winston Churchill Memorial Trust

3. Membership: Any Churchill Fellow resident in Tasmania or awarded a fellowship whilst a resident of Tasmania may be admitted to membership of the Association. A nominated family member of a deceased fellow may become an honorary member of the association.

4. Policy: The Association is not connected with and will not present views or advocate the adoption of the views of any other organisation whatever. Individual members remain free to espouse any cause or champion any organisation whatever.

5. Management: The affairs of the Association shall be managed, by an executive committee which shall consist of:

- (a) President
- (b) Vice President
- (c) Secretary/Treasurer or Secretary AND Treasurer
- (d) 3 committee members

- (e) Any Life Member may become an ex-officio member of the committee without being subject to election but may, if wishing to be and elected to do so, hold office.

Four members shall constitute a quorum and if the President so decides, the votes of the committee may be obtained by telephone or email.

- 6 The members of the Executive Committee shall be elected by the Association members at the Annual General Meeting to be held between 1 May and 30 November each year. Nine members shall constitute a quorum at the Annual General Meeting. Twenty-one days notice of the Annual Meeting will be given to members but failure to notify all members shall not invalidate the meeting or decisions taken at it.
- 7. Annual membership Fees shall be set by the executive committee. The nominated family member of any deceased fellow will be entitled to free honorary membership of the association.
- 8. The secretary/treasurer has authority to open a bank account to be operated upon by the signatures of any two members of the executive committee.
- 9. Life Membership of the Association shall be awarded to any nominated member who has been deemed by a majority vote of the executive committee to have given outstanding service to the association. Such nomination shall be made in writing to the executive committee.
- 10. This constitution can be amended at any general meeting of members.
